
Management – Sustainability Committee

Project milestones: Climate impact reduction

Annual calculation of the organisational carbon footprint

Decarbonisation plan aligned with the Paris Agreements and with the goal of limiting global warming to 1.5°C. Our commitment is:

Reduction of scopes 1 and 2 of our 2022 organisational carbon footprint by 50% (in line with the targets set by the SBTi).
